## **RESEARCHBLOGGING.ORG NOW INCLUDES PEER-REVIEWED RESEARCH IN SPANISH**

NEW YORK (June 1, 2009) – ResearchBlogging.org, the blog platform for discussions surrounding peer-reviewed research, today announced that it now supports blogs in Spanish. Spanish is the third language supported by the site, which has been collating research-related posts in German and English since August 2008.
